Food, cleaning supplies, and toiletries were collected for the Valley Food Bank. They also collected clothing and shoes to be donated to My Sister's Place in Ansonia and two large bags of yarn that will be made into blankets for the Umbrella Shelter. My Sister's Place sells donated items to support the Umbrella Program which services victims of Domestic Violence.

They filled the trunk of a car twice. At least 50% of the items collected for the food bank and all of the yarn were collected with the help of students at the Escola Portuguesa Vasco da Gama in Bridgeport where Lisa is the Parent Representative. F. W. Serra, Inc. is a member of the Valley United Way Corporate Volunteer Council where Carol co-chairs the Food Collection Committee.
